Recipients will be notified on the 18th of the month. If a recipient cannot be contacted within two days, the Bridport Prize reserves the right to reallocate the free entry.

The selected writers must submit their work by email to kate@bridportprize.org.uk by the 28th of the month at the latest.

Writers unable to comply with the submission date will be disqualified.
